



Ste. Genevieve County Community Center Volleyball League Rules

1. A match will consist of 3 sets to 21 points. Rally scoring will be used. A team must win by 2. CAP OF 25.
2. You must have at least 4 players on the court to play a match. You may play with the following scenarios:

3 men, 3 women	2 men, 2 women
2 men, 4 women	2 men, 3 women
1 man, 3 women	1 man, 4 women
1 man, 5 women	0 man, 6, 5, 4 women
3. On the return of serve, the ball may be bumped or set. However, no attack on the ball on the first hit over the net (attack is when contact is made with the ball above the plane of the net).
4. Players must use sportsmanlike conduct at all times; it is the captain's responsibility to control players. The referee will give one warning and after that the player will be ejected from the game. Repeat offenders may face ejection from the league.
5. Rotating players will be rotated into the center back position. Rotation will occur on every side-out
6. **Referee's decision is final.**
7. Forfeits are determined 5 minutes after scheduled game time. For example, if the game time is 6:15pm, the referee will call the forfeit at 6:20pm.
 - a. If a team is short on players and knows they are just running late, a set will be forfeited every 15 minutes until a full team is there to play. Once they player arrives, they will start from the 2nd or 3rd set depending on what time that person arrived.
8. Court rules—if the ball hit by your team hits the ceiling or center basket in the middle of the court, and falls back into your court, it is in play, except if after third hit. A ball that rolls or hits on top of the center basketball net is out of play. The walking track (any side railing), drop down divider, and basketball goals on the sides are considered out of play.
9. Only the team captain may address the officials.
10. Teams may not substitute players from other teams in the same league. No player is allowed to play on multiple teams.
11. The Ste. Genevieve County Community Center will provide the game ball unless both teams agree to the use of another ball.
12. Roster sheets must be given to the referee on the first night of play. Any additions need to be done and signed before they play.
13. A ball may be played off any part of the body, kicking will now be allowed but foot must be planted on ground or in downward motion.
14. USAV rules govern all situations not covered by the Community Center rules.
15. Your team must notify the Community Center ASAP if you know in advance that your team is going to have to forfeit. Please be considerate of the team you are scheduled to play.
16. Most importantly, remember this is a recreational league.
17. **Final Rosters must be made by week 5. A player may be listed on a roster even though he or she has not yet played.**
